### Know your why

After your initial preparation keep asking if you have answered the question of 'why' you are talking about this. Remember, the 'how' won't make sense if you haven't satisfied the 'why'.

### Work on your P's

- Pitch  
*Too high? To low? Preachy voice.*
- Pause  
*Some statements or concepts need a moment to digest before moving on.*
- Pace  
*It's not a race to the finish line.*
- Projection  
*Speak to the room you're in.*

### Evaluate yourself

- Record yourself  
*No one likes to hear their own voice, get over it. Minimize verbal distractions. Practice, practice, practice.*
- Video yourself  
*That's next level, minimize the visual distractions.*
